Permanent supportive housing for families with dependent children

Emergency Crisis Housing Shelters

- ▶ Women and Family Shelter
 - ▶ 27 Bed Facility
 - ▶ 45 Day Maximum Stay
 - ▶ Served 213 people in 104 households
 - ▶ 86% left to a permanent housing situation
- ▶ Men's Shelter
 - ▶ 20 Crisis Housing Beds
 - ▶ 45 day maximum stay
 - ▶ Served 167
 - ▶ 66% left to a permanent housing situation



Emergency Crisis Housing Shelters

- ▶ Low Barrier
- ▶ Client centered
- ▶ Housing/Housing First Focused

Low Barrier Shelter

Only prerequisite to shelter entry: HOMELESS
